## Bagging Wipes

Each month we distribute over 4,000 wipes through the Rainbow Room. For inventory purposes we distribute 8 bags of 10 wipes per child, per visit to the room. If you would like to help keep our baskets stocked, you can bag wipes at home and schedule a pick up or drop off time with PFC staff.

### Supplies needed:

- Ziploc Bags
- Gloves
- Box of Baby Wipes

### Steps to bundle:

1. Please put on gloves before beginning. Your safety and that of our families is our first priority.
2. Open up your box of wipes.
3. Count out 10 wipes, fold them together and place all 10 inside the baggie. If you end up with an extra wipe or two at the end, you can add them to a bag, no biggie if one has an extra or two.
4. Once you have completed bagging all the wipes, place all of the bagged wipes in the box. It's that easy!

\*\*\*Please note, bags of wipes should be emptied of any air to ensure that they stay fresh\*\*\*
